

Report on Attending the APEC Financial Regulators Training Initiative Regional Seminar on Green Finance in Asia and Supervisory Implication

11.28.2019

This seminar was co-organized by the Financial Supervisory Service of Korea (FSS) and the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Experts from the United Kingdom, South Korea, Mainland China, International Climate Bonds Initiative, ADB, Green Climate Fund and other green finance related fields shared on the following topics:

- Why is Green Finance important?
- National Plan on Climate Change in Korea;
- Air pollution(fine dust) and the impact on Green Financing;
- Green Bond, its principles and certification;
- Green Bond cases in Korea and the road ahead;
- Green Finance in Asia;
- The Roles of International Organizations in Green Finance;
- Alignment of the financial system with sustainable development and the Roles of Regulators.

The last day of the seminar was a closed-door meeting. After briefing the green finance situation in the four regions of Mainland China, Japan, ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations, ASEAN), and South Korea, the representatives of other participating countries were invited to exchange views on the country's green finance development progress and experiences. This report summarizes the key points of each discussion agenda, and gives suggestions and feedback.
